The study of the prayer songs we know as the Book of Psalms is a study of mankind's deepest pleas, praise, and prayer. As we devoutly pray or sing the psalms we not only sense a kind of harmony with God, we find that we are in harmony with others who pray or have prayed over the ages. We recognize who we always have been- a child of God:

"It was you that created my inmost self, and put me together in my mother's womb; for all these mysteries I thank you; for the wonder of myself, for the wonder of your works. You know me through and through, from having watched my bones take shape when I was being formed in secret, knitted together in the limbo of the womb. You had scrutinized my every action, all were recorded in your book, my days listed and determined, even before the first of them occurred." *Psalms: 139: 13-17*

About the Holy Trinity

The Father God, is called the Father because from all eternity He begets His only Son. God the Father is unbegotten. Jesus is God the Son, the only begotten of the Father. Proceeding from the Father, He is called the Divine Word or the Wisdom of the Father. Holy Spirit is God: from all eternity He is breathed forth, by the Father and the Son. He is called Proceeding from the Father and the Son, He is called the Gift or Love of the Father and the Son. Adapted from The Baltimore Catechism, no. 3, Lesson 3.

Augustine:

As regards this question, then, let us believe that the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit is one God, the Creator and Ruler of the whole creature; and that the Father is not the Son, nor the Holy Spirit either the Father or the Son, but a trinity of persons mutually interrelated, and a unity of an equal essence (*On the Trinity 9: 1 [A.D. 428]*).

Hippolytus

A man, therefore, even though he will it not, is compelled to acknowledge God the Father Almighty, and Christ Jesus the Son of God, who, being God, became man, to whom also the Father made all things subject, Himself excepted, and the Holy Spirit; and that these, therefore, are three. But if he desires to learn how it is shown still that there is one God, let him know that His power is one. As far as regards the power, therefore, God is one. But as far as regards the economy there is a threefold manifestation, as shall be proved afterwards when we give account of the true doctrine (*Against the Heresy of One Noetus 8 [A.D. 200-210]*).
